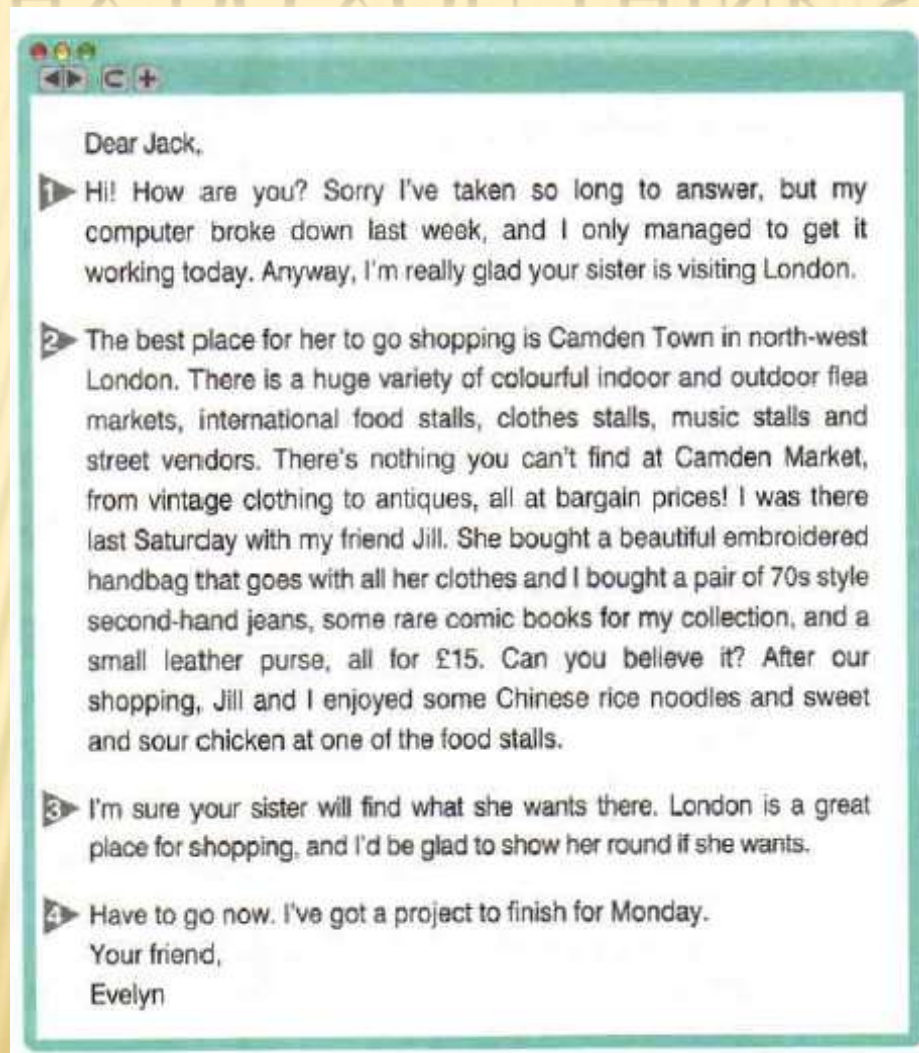

HOW TO START THE LETTER

* обращение должно быть неофициальным

* после обращения ставится запятая

Example:

Dear Tim,

Dear Marry,

THANKING FOR PREVIOUS CONTACTS

упомяните о предыдущих контактах:

Thanks (a lot) for your (last) letter.

Your last letter was a real surprise.

I was glad to get your letter.

It was great to hear from you!

извинитесь за то, что не писали раньше:

Sorry I haven't written for so long but.../Sorry I haven't been in touch for so long.

I'm sorry I haven't answered earlier but I was really busy with my school.

и/или упомяните какой-либо факт из полученного письма:

I'm glad you passed your History test!

Sounds like you had a great time in London.

Great news about your...!

THE BODY OF THE LETTER

обычно 2-3 абзаца

раскройте все аспекты, указанные в задании

используйте неформальные средства связи

(well, by the way, anyway, so)

не забывайте использовать and, but, because

HOW TO FINISH THE LETTER

Объясните, почему заканчиваете письмо:

Well, I'd better go now as I have to do my homework.

Anyway, I have to go now because my mum asked me to help her with the washing up.

I've got to go now! It's time for my favourite TV show.

Упомяните о дальнейших контактах:

Write back soon!

Take care and keep in touch!

Drop me a letter when you can.

Hope to hear from you soon.

I can't wait to hear from you!

CONCLUSION

На отдельной строке напишите завершающую фразу-клише.
